We also welcome a new vintage on our vines and a new crop of wheat on our hills. The wines of the last two years have wintered well with Serge keeping a close watch. Hope you'll join us in tasting during Spring Release Weekend. We will be open at the ranch and downtown.

By the way, if you haven't been in our downtown tasting room at 18 N. Second, you're in for a real treat. Don't just dash in and dash out, but plan time to taste and see the history of Spring Valley unfold on the walls of this special room.

So it is 2009 already and there have been many things to celebrate. We have the hope and promise of new crops and new wines. We have our country, strong enough to weather the storm, and we have a new member of the family with Uriah Royal.

People often ask us if we are sustainable. Apparently we are—at least through seven generations now!

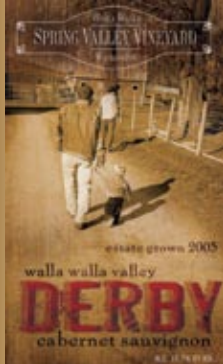
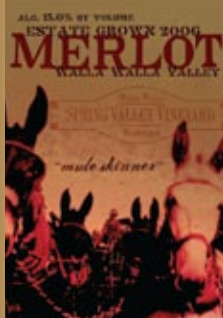
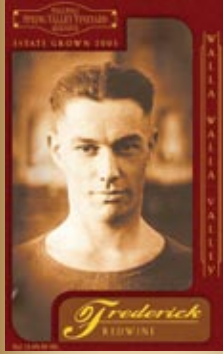
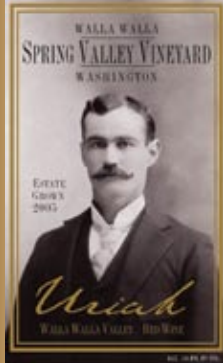

**A NEW RELEASE FOR SPRING**



Springtime brings new buds on the vines and a sweet smell to the Walla Walla wheat fields that I've grown to love.

I'm happy to tell you that this Spring also brings the anticipated release of our 2006 Derby. As with all our wine, this Cabernet Sauvignon selection comes from fruit that is hand-picked from our estate vineyards. The 2006 growing season in Walla Walla began with a mild Spring, followed by a hot, dry Summer which contributed to excellent acidity levels and small berries with concentrated fruit. As a result, our 2006 Derby has a cherry and blackberry nose with a round and lush palate of candied cherry and plum.

Derby completes our 2006 vintage releases, and you've already seen how great they continue to be year after year. I hope you'll have the chance to try this new release soon.

<p>2006 <b>URIAH Merlot Blend</b>—750 ml bottles 93 Points, Wine Spectator A nose of complex dark fruit with hints of cedar, crushed stone, an dry herbs leads into black fruit, licorice, and grenadine syrup on the palate. The perfectly integrated oak leaves no edge and the huge tannins are packed and concentrated but melt on the mouth. This wine has great aging potential and can be enjoyed now.</p>		\$50.00
<p>2006 <b>FREDERICK Cabernet Sauvignon Blend</b>—750 ml bottles There is a lot of muscle in this sixth seductive vintage of Frederick. The nose is bright with scents of licorice and blackberry. The mouth feel is huge with a concentration of dark ripe black fruit. As usual, the tannins are richly present with exceptional quality, adding to a lingering, soft finish.</p>		\$50.00
<p>2006 <b>NINA LEE 100% Syrah</b>—750 ml bottles Long hang time makes for amazing quality fruit on the vines. An elegant nose with the traditional wheat harvest effect. The mouth feel is full of ripe berries, a mélange of summer fruits, and fresh baked vanilla and berry cobbler.</p>		\$50.00
<p>2006 <b>MULE SKINNER 100% Merlot</b>—750 ml bottles The mouth feel is full of sweet ripe berries, a mélange of summer fruits, and fresh baked vanilla and berry cobbler. The tannins are sweet with a long, generous finish.</p>		\$45.00
