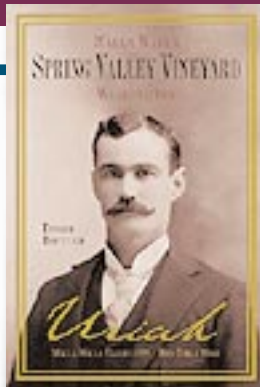

Tasting Notes

The Estate Bottled 1999 URIAH made it's debut as a complete and complex blend of 59% Merlot, 35% Cabernet Franc and 6% Petit Verdot. Having a deep dark cherry color and a nose of spun sugar, ripe berry and cherry, URIAH is an elegant, well balanced wine of medium weight. Layers of lush fruit, sweet spices and a smoky middle palate round out to a long, creamy, raspberry finish. URIAH will continue to evolve beautifully in the cellar for many years.

1999 URIAH is In the Bottle

After spending 14 months in French and American oak barrels, the 1999 vintage of URIAH is now in the bottle. In mid December, with the guidance and expertise of Myles Anderson/Gordon Venneri, and, with the help of family and friends, we bottled just over 900 cases. We plan to make as many bottles available to our retail customers as possible. The remainder will be distributed to select restaurants and wine shops throughout the nation.
